

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WALKING WISELY WEEKEND 2023

What does the registration fee include?

The cost of the W3 Weekend includes guest speaker, band, production, t-shirt, a small group outing and all meals for the weekend.

Where will my student be staying during W3?

Your student will be assigned a Host Home with their small group. All adults staying in the home will be properly background checked. Your student's small group leader will contact you with all the necessary information. When it comes to where your student will sleep, you would be amazed how many students can pile into one area! Your student's small group leaders will be staying in the same room to keep an eye on things.

Are parents allowed to come to Walking Wisely for the sessions?

Yes, we would love to have you! You are invited to all the sessions. There will be an area reserved for hosts, parents, and drivers.

How will my student get to and from the church and their Host Home?

We will have designated drivers, that have been through a background check. They will be transporting all of our students from Host Homes to events at the church each day.

Will my student be able to drive?

In order to maintain the small group environment we create, no high school students will be able to drive during the W3 Weekend. Special requests can be made on a case by case basis if your student needs to leave for an event.

Will there be a medical professional at Walking Wisely?

Yes, we will have a nurse present throughout the weekend. If your student takes medication, please fill out our "Medication Card". These forms can be turned into your students small group leaders' at drop off. They are available in the church office, Next Steps Kiosk, and online under our Walking Wisely Event.

Who do I contact in case of emergency?

In the case of an emergency, parents should contact their students through their small group leaders.

Will there be security on campus during Walking Wisely?

Yes, security will be present on campus throughout the weekend.

What if my student has a food allergy?

Please indicate if your student has any allergies in the appropriate spot when registering. We will happily accommodate them.

What if my student has a prior commitment during the W3 Weekend?

If your student needs to leave W3 for any reason, you, the parent, must fill out a "Time Away" card. They are available in the church office, Next Steps Kiosk, and online under our Walking Wisely Event. This information will be shared with your student's small group leader so they are aware of your student's departure and return to the event and can coordinate accordingly with you.

Is there anything needed for registration in addition to the online form?

Yes, a consent/liability release is required to be signed and notarized by parents in order for their student to attend. You can drop this form at the church and have it notarized by one of our notaries during business hours (Monday - Thursday 8:30AM-4:00PM). Additional waivers may be needed depending on the outing your students small group leader chooses.

Where do I drop off and pick up my student?

Drop off and pick up will be at your student's Host Home. Friday night, students will check in, with their luggage, at their Host Home prior to dinner and the first session. Designated drivers will drive to the church for the evening's activities. If your student is arriving late to Church at Viera on Friday evening, there will be a designated room for them to drop off their luggage. You will pick up your student at their Host Home on Sunday morning.
