## **PURPOSE OF POSITION**

Discipleship Ministry is hiring Childcare Workers to fill morning (Wednesdays) and evening (Monday-Thursday) positions starting immediately. Responsibilities include providing a safe, clean, and nurturing environment for children, and helping to meet their physical and emotional needs

## **JOB RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Care: Provide age-appropriate care, such as feeding, diapering, and toileting
- **Safety:** Ensure the classroom is a safe environment for children; keep gates closed at all times; never leave children unsupervised; ensure all children and parents have the appropriate identification labels
- Cleanliness: Maintain a clean and organized room; Clean and sanitize all toys before putting them away; Demonstrate good hygiene by washing your hands and wearing gloves when changing diapers, wiping noses, serving snacks etc.
- Interaction: Greet parents and children, and interact with children in a cheerful manner
- Communication: Oversee the check-in and check-out process, and communicate with parents; report all concerns or issues to Childcare Team Leader or Childcare Coordinator immediately
- Supervision: Arrive before your shift begins and stay until the last child is picked up
- Play: Play with children or direct their play in an age-appropriate way
- Patience: Exhibit Christ-like patience
- **Availability:** Provide weekly availability to Childcare Coordinator and commit to shifts in advance
